

# **CONFERENCE VENUE**

TIO 2016 Conference will be held in Čačak, Serbia, at the Faculty of Technical Sciences, Svetog Save 65, from 28<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2016.

#### **ABOUT THE CONFERENCE**

The conference continues the tradition of successful realization of the previous five conferences with international participation held in 2006, 2008, 2010, 2012, 2014. This year for the first time, the conference will be organized as an International scientific gathering (M33). More than 1000 participants attended the previous conferences and more than 500 scientific papers were published in conference proceedings.

# **THEMATIC FIELDS**

The main theme of the conference is technical and IT education at all levels. A comprehensive analytical review will be given on the state of education in this field as well as the contribution of technical and IT education to other fields. The papers will be classified into following sections:

- Challenges in technical and IT education from preschool to university
- Remote experiments NeReLa Demo section
- Information and Educational Technologies
- Professional development of IT and technical education teachers
- Engineering Education
- Technical and Technological Education in European perspective

### **REGISTRATION FEE**

Registration fee for the participants from Serbia is 5000 dinars, while for the participants from abroad it amounts to 50 euros. ### **PAPER INFORMATION**

Several introductory statements will be issued in the thematic session. Themes of the papers should be compatible with the thematic fields of the meeting. Authors should suggest the thematic field of their papers. The size of the papers should be from four to six pages. If necessary, the number of pages can be larger. In that case the registration fee will be higher due to the increased printing costs (500 dinars per each page over 6 pages). The papers will be reviewed by the reviewers appointed by the Scientific Committee.

One person can submit a maximum of two papers, as the first and second author.

The paper must comply with the requirements for conference paper writing that have been accepted for TIO 2014. Thus, all the papers in the conference proceedings will have the same structure. If the paper presents a theoretical approach, it should be structured in the following way:

- Summary (max 150 words)
- ➢ Key words (max 5 words)
- Introduction (introduction in the problem analysed)
- The main part of the paper (it should include: the purpose of theoretical research/analysis and the main problem, data sources, main arguments and explanations, interpretations. All of this, if necessary, can be organized in functional subtitles).
- Conclusion/conclusions
- References

If the paper presents an empirical approach, it should be structured in the following way:

- Summary (max 150 words)
- Key words (max 5 words)
- ➢ Introduction (introduction in the problem and theoretical, empirical framework of the research)
- Methodology /Research organization /application description (if the paper presents a description of a software solution)
- Results and discussion, implications
- Conclusion/conclusions
- > References

The paper will be accepted for TIO 2016 Conference under the following conditions:

- The paper is submitted before the expected deadline;
- The paper is written in compliance with the given instruction;
- If the paper is positively reviewed;
- The registration fee is paid.
